- Firstly, our side event titled "UN COPUOS and ITU Regimes: Synergies and Best Practices".. The side event will take place tonight at the ESPI Premises at 18:30, and it will be organised in collaboration with Secure World Foundation (SWF).
- Secondly, we invite you to the 3rd Inter-Regional Space Policy Dialogue between the Asia-Pacific and Europe, jointly organized with the Asia-Pacific Regional Space Agency Forum, which will be held next Saturday, June 3rd, at 9:30 at our premises. This dialogue will focus on national approaches to space sustainability and the implementation of LTS Guidelines.
- Finally, the inaugural VSD summer reception will take place on July 13th with the Permanent Representation of the Grand Duchy of Luxembourg as host.

In conclusion, Honourable Chair and Distinguished Delegates, ESPI is committed to supporting the development of a resilient, sustainable, and responsible space sector.
