ESPI 20th Anniversary: an example of space diplomacy

On 25 September, ESPI celebrated its 20th Anniversary at the Austrian Parliament with guests from over 40 countries including government and industry leaders, executives of international organisations, heads of space agencies, ambassadors, parliamentarians, members of the VSD community and representatives from NASA, JAXA, ISRO, and KARI. The event featured opening remarks from key figures including Austria's Federal Minister Leonore Gewessler, and ESA's Director General Josef Aschbacher followed by a roundtable on European space policy and a panel offering international perspectives on space cooperation.

The highlight was the launch of ESPI's policy vision for Europe in space "ESPI2040: Space for Prosperity, Peace, and Future Generations", with contributions from Etienne Schneider, former Deputy Prime Minister of Luxembourg, and European astronaut Samantha Cristoforetti. Announcements included new ESPI members and agreements, international cooperation initiatives, and the establishment of the ESPI Centre of Excellence for Space and Sustainability.

Titled "The Strategic Value of Earth Observation: Maximising Benefits for Governments and International Community," this joint ESPI-ISPRS event will feature a moderated panel discussion, offering insights into the expansive impact of Earth Observation technologies.

I would also like to extend an invitation to all VSD members for the inaugural VSD forum, set for March 6th, 2024. This forum will open with an in-depth discussion on space weather, an often-overlooked issue of critical importance for our society. The session will begin with a Fireside Chat by an ESPI expert and a guest speaker, followed by an interactive Q&A session. This will be followed by a networking reception, offering an open platform for engagement.


